KNOWLEDGE & SKILL

- Good understanding and knowledge of Ryobi sheet-fed 4-color presses;
- Ability to mix inks;
- Good knowledge of paper;
- Eye for color;
- Good listening, oral and written communication skills;
- Accurately interpret verbal and written instructions from customers and sales staff to ensure customer satisfaction;
- Demonstrate problem solving skills;
- Recognition and knowledge of safety standards required for equipment operation;
- High accuracy in work – attention to detail;
- Ability to measure and count accurately – must know how to read a ruler;
- Mechanical ability to do minor equipment repairs;
- Minimum of five years of experience on a sheet-fed 4-color press.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- Requires standing (70%), walking (15%), and bending (15%);
- Work positions include standing, kneeling, and squatting, with extended reach above head and extended reach in front of body (above 18 inches and in front 30 inches);
- Good hand-eye coordination;
- Lifts materials up to 40 pounds;
- Requires pushing loaded dollies weighing up to 500 pounds up to five times per shift for distances up to 100 feet;
- Requires working on ladders, catwalks, and supports at heights up to 10 feet;
- Requires work with hand tools weighing up to 10 pounds in positions below head.
